### **1992 Holiday Bowl – University of Hawaii vs University of Illinois**



**Travis Sims running for a touchdown**

**The 1992 Holiday Bowl featured the University of Hawaii Rainbow Warriors defeating the University of Illinois Fighting Illini 27-17. This was Hawaii's first-ever bowl victory on the mainland and capped off an 11-2 season for the Rainbow Warriors. Michael Carter of Hawaii was named the game's Outstanding Offensive Player, while Junior Tagoai earned Outstanding Defensive Player honors.**

**The Rainbow Warriors, coached by Bob Wagner, were led by quarterback Michael Carter, who had 115 passing yards and 105 rushing yards. Running back Travis Sims set three UH bowl records with 113 rushing yards, 29 carries, and 2 touchdowns. Besides Carter and Sims, Hawaii's Jason Elam contributed with field goals of 47 and 37 yards.**

**The win was significant for Hawaii, as it was their first bowl victory outside of Hawaii and helped them earn a share of their first WAC championship title, finishing the season ranked #20 in the AP poll. The 1992 team was later inducted into the UH Sports Circle of Honor.**



**The University of Hawaii's 1992 football team, which won the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) title and the Holiday Bowl, was honored during a 30th-anniversary celebration in 2022. The celebration included a reunion weekend with the team members and their families, a pre-game reception, and on-field recognition during a game against Wyoming. The team was also presented with a special "Ki'i" (tiki statue) to commemorate their achievements.**
